Helen Thomas was a senior White House correspondent who covered every President from Kennedy to Obama. Her manner was direct, blunt, demanding and unrelenting. In an interview in *Ms* magazine in 2006 she said "I respect the office of the presidency, but I never worship at the shrines of our public servants. They owe us the truth." In the early 2000's Fidel Castro was asked what the difference was between democracy in the United States and democracy in Cuba.
