Brandied Cranberries

1lb. fresh cranberries1-2/3 c. sugar1/3 c. brandy

Bake for an hour at 250 degrees in glass dish. Place cranberries no more than two layers deep. Pour sauce over vanilla ice cream. Serves 8.

Barbed-Wire Sugar Cookies

2 eggs 1/2 lb. butter 1 tsp. vanilla 2 c. flour

Bake 350 degree oven for 8 minutes.

Roll dough into oblong shapes (or Christmas trees.) Snip 6" lengths of barbed wire and press into your dough. Bake as usual.
