President Donald J. Trump appears to be very good at changing Right Wing dreams into reality, dreams such as a Supreme Court which will allow the negation of the forty-hour work week, work place safety and the destruction of our environment for more profits. With the Trump Party controlling Congress, he was able to cut taxes mostly for the ultra-rich and corporations, for unlike Tax-and-Spend Democrats, he is a Borrow-and-Spend Republican. He has derided the value of NATO, giving the United States an appearance of extreme unreliability as an ally, thereby sowing the seeds that could bring a 1950's Right Wing conspiracy theory nightmare to fruition.

During the late 1940's my mother began listening to an assortment of radio evangelists. One evangelist concentrated on UFO covers up by the Federal Government, another concentrated on attacking supposed communists in Hollywood. In the early 1950's a radio evangelist sent his son to Europe to investigate the possibility of a feared United States of Europe forming with military forces that would challenge the dominance of the United States. The son reported that with the success of the Marshall Plan in restarting European economies, a formidable military machine was possible if the countries could put aside their differences and unite, bearing in mind that it took the three strongest world powers and their satellites to defeat one European country and its satellites during World War II. The countries have united and President Trump's insincerity and bullying may provide the incentive for building a European Force totally independent of America.
