At the end of that day I showed the Academy's volunteer coordinator this fabulous pile of cards. She took pictures of them and put the photos in the weekly online school newsletter that week indicating what they were and how I had volunteered two days a week for years.

The personal messages from these mostly sweet kids made all the bad days when the kids didn't behave worth it.
